## What's it all about?

The Weekend Warriors is a National Program that provides opportunities for musicians and singers of all ages and skill levels to participate in live music. You don't have to be a super star to get involved. Whether you have played in a band before or have simply always wanted to, this program gives you an avenue to take part in live-music.

## How does it work?

The Program starts with a free coached JAM SESSION with all gear supplied. This is where you get up and give it your best shot. Songs are negotiated on the fly and you discover (or rediscover) the adrenalin rush of performing live music. Once everyone has attempted a couple of songs, people are shuffled around until everyone has had a chance to strut their stuff.

Up to this point there is no charge to participants. People then decide if they want to go through the program, after which a fee applies. Once commitment has been given by those wanting to progress through THE ROUND, coaches then have the difficult task of grouping people into bands with complementary skill levels and musical preferences. Newly formed bands then meet to discuss which songs they may want to learn for a 30 minute set list.

Within a week or so, bands then commence 4 x 2 hour REHEARSAL SESSIONS over the next 4 weeks, under the guidance of a professional coach, with all gear supplied. This is a great fun part of the process as everyone feels the thrill of building something new and special. Many lasting friendships have begun in the rehearsal rooms of AIMMS School of Rock.

## The Grand Finale

After the rehearsing is over, you are part of a very exciting event... your new bands DEBUT PERFORMANCE. That is where all bands from your round play a 30 minute set to an enthusiastic live audience. These concerts are usually held at the Governor Hindmarsh Hotel (The GOV) and are well supported by other members of the Warriors Association and family and friends.
